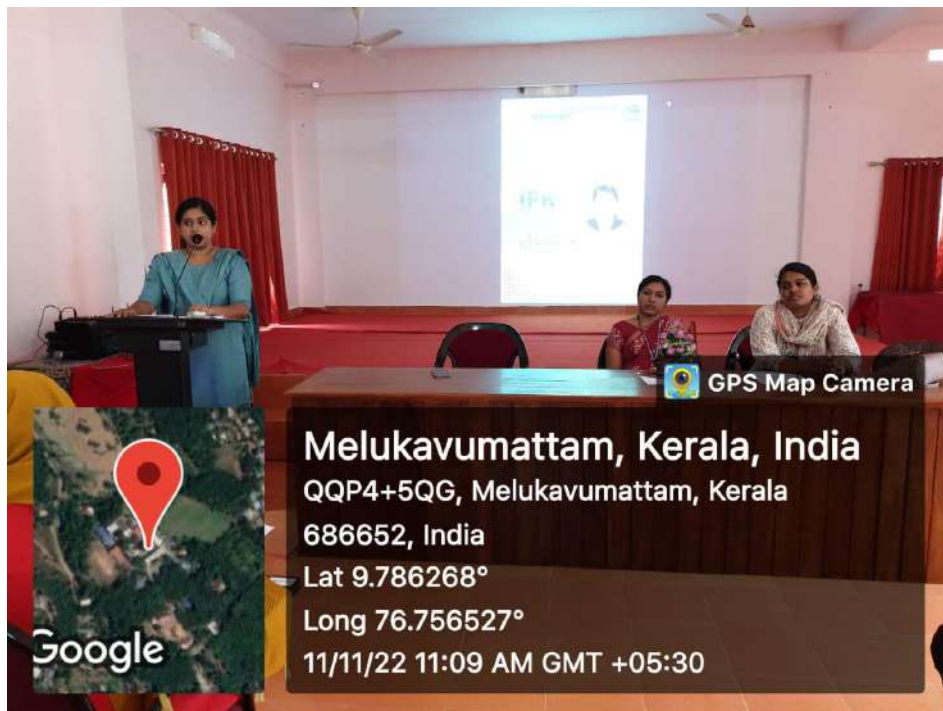

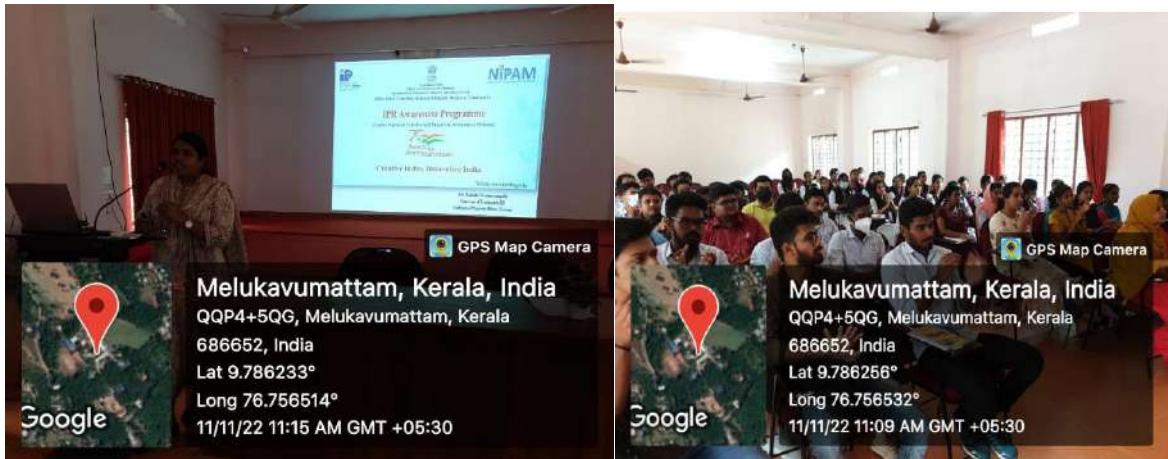
Outcome: The event effectively fulfilled its mission of educating and raising awareness among students about the complex and vital world of intellectual property rights.



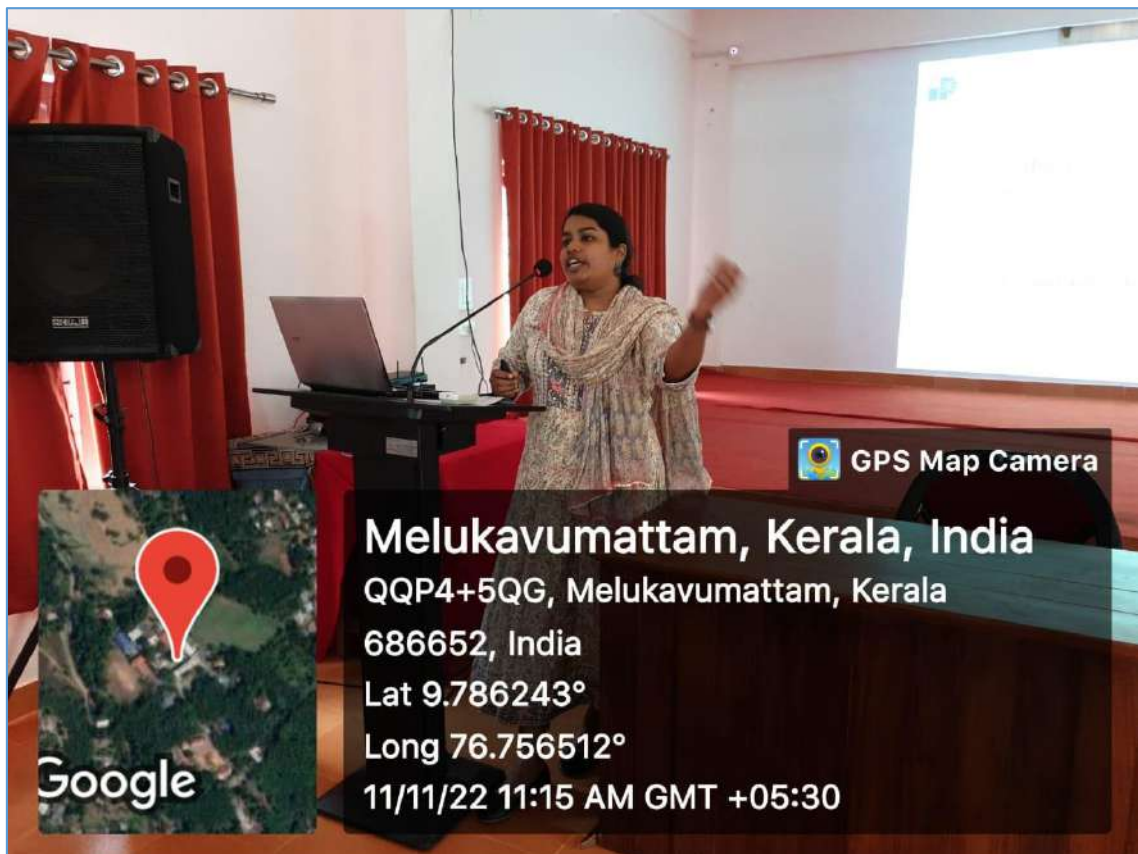
