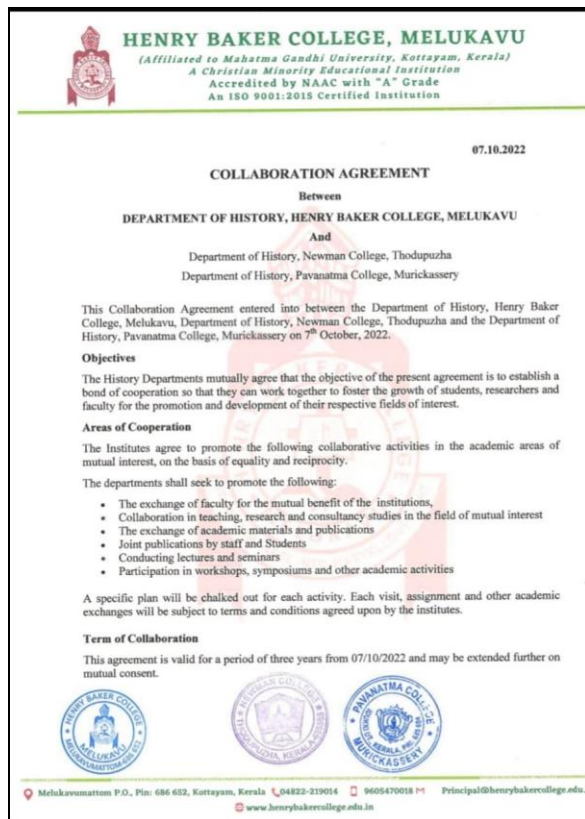
#### **Objective**

The workshop was to enrich History teachers in doing History in the contemporary age.

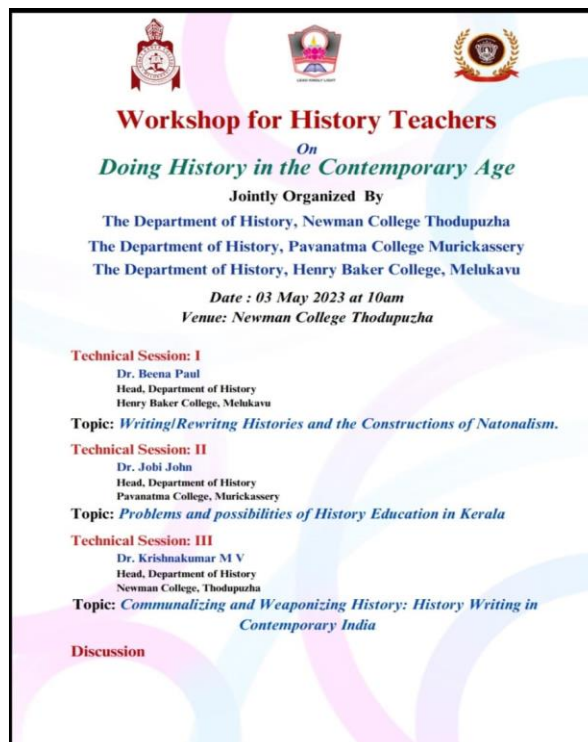




